**Q- What are the visiting hours?**

Visitation is Tuesdays and Fridays from 8:30-10:00 and from 1:00-3:00 on a first come-first served basis. An inmate must be here 7 days before visits are allowed and you must be on the inmate's visitation list.

**Q- What are the visitation days?**

Visitation is Tuesdays and Fridays from 8:30-10:00 and from 1:00-3:00.

**Q- When are inmates allowed visitors?**

An inmate is not allowed visitors the first 7 days.

**Q- How do I send money to an inmate or place money on an inmate's commissary account?**

Cash deposits may be made Monday through Friday 8:00-5:00 or through the mail with a money order.

**Q- Is my family member in jail?**

Incarceration information is available through the [Vine system link](#) .

**Q- What is the Court Clerks telephone number?**

The phone number for the Court Clerk is 405-321-6402.



**Q- What is the maximum amount I can put on commissary?**

The maximum amount is limited to \$50.00 per day.

**Q- When may clergy visit?**

Clergy may visit on Sunday.

**Q- Am I on the visitation list?**

Current visitation list information is available at the front desk or call 321-8600.

**Q- What is the District Attorney's telephone number?**

The telephone number for the District Attorney's office is 405-321-8268.

**Q- What is my family member's court date?**

Court date information is available by calling the court clerk's office, 405-321-6402.

**Q- How do I file a Victims Protective Order?**

You must go to the Court Clerk's Office at 201 N. Peters and complete the paperwork as directed by their staff.

**Q- How do I know if a property is on a Sheriff's Sale?**

**Q- How do I evict someone from my property?**

If rent is behind you must issue a five day notice of eviction. If rent is not behind you must issue a thirty day notice of eviction. After the designated time has elapsed, you must file a Forcible Entry and Detainer at the Small Claims Office of the Court Clerk.
